

Local Power-Pop Band Clifton Beat Releases New Album @BevyBirdtown

Lakewood trio the [Clifton Beat](#) isn't particularly well known around the area, but the kind of music they make — tuneful, guitar-driven power pop with lots of vocal harmonies — is a kind that's been associated with Cleveland since the '60s. And the members — guitarist Bill Rouse, bassist Mark Bluhm and drummer Paul Nickels — have been playing around the area for quite a while, although they're not even two years old as the Clifton Beat.

The group is now releasing its debut CD, *Pushing Back the End of Time*. They'll [celebrate with a show](#) at Lakewood's Bevy in Birdtown with Brian Lisik & the Unfortunates also performing. Admission is \$8 in advance, \$10 at the door, and that includes a copy of the album.
